


Indications:

3M Steri-Drape Ioban 2 Specialty Drapes are used to create a sterile field for the surgical procedure. They are intended for external use only.

Directions for use:

- Disinfect the surgical or operative site according to hospital policy or physician-prescribed routine.
- 2. Make sure skin is dry.
- 3. Apply drape to thoroughly dry intact skin; smooth with a sterile towel.
- 4. To remove an adhered area, gently peel back at 180 degree angle from the skin. This means folding the adhered area back on itself and maintaining that angle while pulling the film away from the skin (see figure A and B). During the removal process hold onto the adhered area with the thumb and hand as close as possible to the junction of the skin and adhesive. This prevents severe stretching. Skin of elderly patients is typically fragile and thus requires even greater care when applying and removing adhesive products such as drapes.





For all Steri-Drape Ioban products:

· For best results, store at room temperature. Avoid excessive heat and humidity.
